1. RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) .

- 1.2. Spare.
- 1.3. On this moment no Racing rule(s) will be changed. However the sailing instructions may change rules. In that case the changes will be written in full
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the text in the English language will take precedence.
- 1.5. Every person on board who has his domicile in the Netherlands shall have the appropriate license.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. The sailing instructions will be available after 09-07-2025 19:00.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. *ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The event is open to all boats of the Javelin class(es).
- 4.2. Classes are defined as follows:

- 4.5. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

- 10.4. The following equipment may be inspected or measured: Sails.
- 10.5. [DP] Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1

- 15.2. Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 15.3.
 - 15.3.1. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - 15.3.2. When 5, 6, 7 or 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - 15.3.3. When 9, 10, 11 or 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
 - 15.3.4. When 13 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.
- 15.4. Spare.
- 15.5. RRS 90.3(e) applies.

16. [DP] SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 16.1. Support person vessels shall be marked with RC.

17. DATA PROTECTION

- 17.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

18. RISK STATEMENT

- 18.1. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 18.2. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

19. INSURANCE

- 19.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.500.000 or the equivalent per incident.

20. PRIZES

- 20.1. The prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
